

NWCC ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

Northwest Community College offers 11 annual Entrance Scholarships of \$2000 to applicants from publicly funded schools within the region served by Northwest Community College. Scholarships will be designated for the communities of Haida Gwaii, Hazelton, Houston, Kitimat, the Nass Valley, Prince Rupert (2) Smithers, Stewart and Terrace (2).

Selection will be based on the highest GPA's obtained by Entrance Scholarship applicants from each of the above communities. The applicants' school and community contributions will be considered. The following conditions apply:

- A minimum GPA of 3.00 on all grade 11 and 12 courses shown on the B.C. secondary school transcript.
- Applicants are expected to graduate from grade 12 in the year that they enter the college. A deferral of up to one year may be requested.
- Applicants must apply to and enroll in a full-time (100%) post-secondary course load at NWCC.

To apply, submit an NWCC Scholarship Application form and a transcript of grade 11 and 12 grades. Applicants who are still completing their final high school semester must submit an Interim Transcript issued by their high school. Submit applications to:
