

We are excited to invite you to the annual **Test Drive NWCC** weekend at the Northwest Community College Terrace Campus. This program is on **May 26 & 27, 2018** and is for students currently in grades 10, 11, and 12. This event will enable you to experience campus life by taking part in hands-on workshops and events on campus.

One-hour sessions will introduce students to a variety of academic and technical subjects including Trades, Arts & Sciences (University Credit), Business, Health and Criminology. These will expose you to different programs and career paths available at NWCC.

Student life is part of this experience, so you will be able to take part in interactive and social activities on campus.

Details

- Test Drive NWCC is **FREE**. It includes 1 night accommodation, all meals (lunch & dinner on May 26; and breakfast & lunch on May 27), healthy snacks and entertainment.
- Canteen:** While healthy food & snacks will be provided, students can choose to bring a small amount of money to purchase additional treats from our canteen.
- Check-in:** 11:00 am-12:00 pm on Saturday, May 26 in the Waap Haaw̓k Cafeteria (building #11).
- Check-out:** 2 pm-3 pm on Sunday, May 27 in the cafeteria.
- Overnight stay:** You will be assigned a dorm room. Make sure to bring your own bedding.
- Transportation:** If travelling from out of town, please arrange your trip to and from Terrace.
- Internet access:** Students will have access to free Wi-Fi Internet on campus.

Chaperones

If you are arriving as part of a group of more than 3 students, your group will need to be accompanied by a chaperone (parent or community member). Chaperones will not be charged for meals or accommodations and are welcome to participate in all activities. ***Please note** chaperones are not eligible to win prizes. Dorm rooms will be assigned to chaperones. It is a community's responsibility to ensure chaperones meet the legal requirements including a current Criminal Record Check. **Please provide us your chaperone's name and documentation one week prior to Test Drive.**

Accommodations

Residence buildings have a washroom with showers on each floor; a lounge with TV/DVD player and phone; a kitchen with fridge, freezer, microwave, and washer/dryer. Each room is furnished with a single bed, study desk, dresser and closet. Students and chaperones will need to bring their own bedding (bottom sheet, sleeping bag or blankets), towels, and toiletries.

Safety & Student Conduct

Chaperones and staff will be on campus and accessible throughout the program. Campus Security will also be on site Saturday from 6 pm – 3 am and Sunday from 10am – 6pm. Students will be expected to follow the rules as outlined in the Residence Handbook (NO alcohol or drugs, NO overnight visitors). **Failure to abide by the rules of the Handbook will result in disciplinary action and removal from the program at the students' expense. All events will take place on the Terrace Campus and students are not allowed to travel off campus.**

Photos

For promotional purposes, NWCC regularly takes photos (and sometimes video) at events and activities on campus. Photos are also used to promote NWCC via social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter), the NWCC.ca website, print materials, program and event posters, etc.
